Second Hand Textbook Sale

The second hand textbook sale will be run by the senior school students themselves. They are entirely optional. Each student will be assigned a spot in the school library, at a trestle table, on **Wednesday 28 November**. Students will sell their textbooks to the Grade below. Prices may be set by you and all money made on the day will be kept by you.

A small table hiring fee of **R50** will be charged by the school. Any books that are not sold may be taken home again or donated to the library.

A small amount of textbooks will be available for loan from the library. Stock will depend on returns made by current students.

Here are the sale times for each Grade:

(E.g. Grade 7 students would buy their Grade 8 textbooks between 08:30 and 09:30)

Grade 8, 10 and 12 textbook sale: 08:30 - 09:30

Grade 9 and 11 textbook sale: 10:30 - 11:30

Gr 8 will have the opportunity to sell their textbooks on 27 November from 11:30 -12:30 in the library.

Students joining St Joseph's Marist College from other schools will also be invited to buy books on the day.

*Please keep in mind that if you ordering **NEW textbooks** from Scholars Bookshop, orders and payment must be emailed to the bookshop no later than **Friday 30 November 2018**, in order that your books are delivered on time in 2019.*
